INTRODUCTION

We as a church, and as individual believers, have been marked by God for specific things. You probably know that First Assembly Community Ministries is changing our name this summer to River City Church. Our name may be changing, but our Identity as a church isn't. How it is that God has marked us, our purpose as a church, isn't changing at all!

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

1. When you were a child or teen, how did you see your life would be at your age now?
2. Where there is no vision, the people perish... - Proverbs 29:18
Pastor Robby shared that having a vision for our life will bring three things; focus, endurance, and fulfillment. Share about a time in your life where you were sure you were EXACTLY where God wanted you to be and how He provided focus, endurance, and/or fulfillment for you.
3. Sometimes we can be doing well at what we are doing, but not doing what God wants us to do; much like the Olympic shooter who hit the bullseye- of the wrong target. Is there an area of your life that you feel might not be exactly where God wants you, even if you are doing it well?
4. On Sunday, Pastor Robby shared 3 points to Discovering your Purpose that we should each examine.
 - a. What am I doing that I should not be doing? (Romans 12:2 and Proverbs 4:25-27)
 - b. What am I not doing that I should be doing? (James 4:17 and Matthew 6:34)
 - c. Why not do it today? 2 Corinthians 6:2)

Consider each of these steps and discuss what God is calling you to do differently.
