INTRODUCTION

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

 - a. Admit that you need help. (Luke 15:15-17)
 - b. Humbly repent to God and others. (Luke 15:18)
 - c. Daily choose to reject Satan's lies. (Luke 15:29-31)
 - d. Daily choose to receive God's truth. (Luke 15:22-24)

Talk about which of these you find you do well and which you struggle with.

5. This message was based on the parable of the prodigal son. Which character in the parable do you most identify with at this time? Has this changed throughout your life?
