3. “Futures are shaped by steps of faith.” What area in your life are you seeking a break-through? What is God asking you to do next?
4. “Jonathan knew that his weakness did not weaken God.” What weakness or challenge have you been hiding behind? What step can you take to let go of this hindrance?
5. “Jonathan refused to live safely.” Do you live safely or do you “throw caution to the wind” for God?
6. “Legacy’s are never built by people who live safely.” What kind of legacy do you want to live? What step do you need to take to help develop that legacy?
