- We have assisted in the planting of 7 churches in our community, but this will be new phase of directly planting the DNA of River City Church in another area.

MULTISITE TIMELINE + INVESTMENT

January 2018		Begin forming a leadership team from members of River City excited to bring a new church to West Lafayette
April 2018	+	Begin regular meetings with a launch team who will form the core of the new church
August 2018		Begin services in new location with entire launch team
September 2018		Grand Opening of new location

As a church we will invest financially and receive matching funds between \$30-\$45,000 to make this new church campus a possibility with a total budget of \$60-\$90,000. Initially in a portable location (such as a school), we will strive to provide an excellent church environment for all ages.

PARIS | February 2017

Early in 2017, a team of 13 people, including 3 couples and 7 individuals, journeyed to Paris, France to assist The Bridge, an international, English-speaking church in the western suburbs of the city. Their main goal was to demolish and remodel office space, turning it into a community center for the church. At the end of the week, bathrooms had been completely retiled, most of the plumbing was complete, walls had been moved and rehung, and there was new flooring installed throughout the space. The church now has a permanent place of their own to use as a central location for their work throughout the city. A bonus for this team was getting to know Todd & Amanda Tyson. They led The Bridge as lead pastors before moving to River City Church in August 2017 where Todd now serves as the Executive Pastor.



HAITI | June 2017

A team of 19 went to Croix-des-Bouquets, Haiti to work in partnership with Convoy of Hope and the local Assemblies of God church. The team worked on the construction of the high school expansion, building a foundation for more classroom space. Members of the team were also able to minister to people in the village by digging kitchen gardens and by working alongside nurses to help provide free healthcare clinics and screenings for diabetes and blood pressure. They also provided meals for school children, and were able to donate computers to the high school computer lab.



EL SALVADOR | July 2017

A team of 13 River City Students went on a 9-day missions trip to San Salvador, El Salvador where they worked alongside Don and Terri Triplett of King's Castle Ministries. While there, they went to various communities and schools, leading a total of 7 programs for children and youth, reaching 700 people! In addition, they held two days of soccer tournaments which drew in crowds enabling them to minister to both the youth on the team and the spectators. Our team is the only team to have ever held these tournaments. They saw 110 decisions made for Christ while they were there as well as many healings! It was such a powerful, lifechanging trip for both our team and the people in El Salvador.

OUTREACH + INVOLVEMENT IN THE GREATER LAFAYETTE COMMUNITY

ADVENTURE STATION + S.T.E.A.M. ACADEMY | River City Church has two daycare/preschool programs that currently have 249 children enrolled.

BIBLE STUDY FELLOWSHIP (BSF) | For 30 weeks of the year, River City Church opens its doors to hundreds of women involved in BSF, an interdenominational Bible study for women.

FELLOWSHIP OF CHRISTIAN ATHLETES | During the school year, the River City Student Ministries pastors attend FCA meetings and student lunch times.

GLOBAL LEADERSHIP SUMMIT (GLS) | Each fall, River City Church is the host-site for the GLS, a 2-day event, open to anyone in the community, which provides fresh, actionable, and inspiring leadership content that is relevant both in and outside the church.

HEART2HEART | This ministry mentors, disciples, and provides for basic needs of incarcerated women re-entering our community.

INTERNATIONAL FRIENDSHIP PROGRAM AT PURDUE | Throughout the year, the International Community Ministry `adopts' international students.

J.C. KIDS | Every week, this program ministers to 175 students in the community.

KLOTHING FOR KING'S KIDS | This mobile ministry distributes clothing and household items to local neighborhoods in need.

LIFE SKILLS CLASS PARTNERSHIPS | River City Church acts as a jobsite for various students in local Life Skills classes in our community.

RIVER CITY COMMUNITY CENTER | \$1,248,280 raised as of the end of October 2017.

CONVOY OF HOPE COMMUNITY DAY

On October 13, 2018, River City Church will host a Convoy of Hope Community Event. Convoy of Hope is a faith-based, humanitarian organization that has helped over 65 million needy people since its founding in 1994. This Community Event will:

- Provide \$1 million of goods and services to needy families in Greater Lafayette
- Allow neighbors to help neighbors
- Invite guests of honor (event participants) to experience a poverty-free day
- Introduce local resources for long-term solutions to poverty
- Bring together non-profits, businesses, churches, and government agencies
- Connect community needs with our community's solutions for lasting change

This event comes on the success of the 2016 event during which River City Church galvanized over 500 volunteers from 20 churches and 60 businesses and organizations from the Greater Lafayette Community to distribute free goods and services to approximately 2300, including:

- 135 flu shots
- 1,614 Children's shoes
- 1,410 Women's shoes
- 1,900 socks
- 12,000 smoothies by Plum Organics
- 250 Family portraits
- 266 haircuts
- 705 breast cancer consultations

The event not only served physical needs, but provided an opportunity to pray with 799 individuals.

RIVER CITY COMMUNITY CENTER

The development of the River City Community Center continues with the launch of the Resource and Education Hub. This space will be used as a location for prayer groups, counseling sessions, small meetings, and classes on topics such as tax preparation, job search, and English as a Second Language. It will also house the River City Food Pantry, opening in early 2018.

In November 2017, River City Church, Adventure Station, and STEAM Academy generously gave over 5,000 pounds of non-perishable goods to help supply this food pantry. To supplement those gifts, we became an agency partner with Food Finders Food Bank. That partnership allows us to stretch our purchasing power of financial donations to as much as five times what a similar purchase at a local grocer might produce.

Anyone who is interested in serving at the food pantry can submit their contact information at the Connection Counter. We always welcome volunteers, and we are excited to be able to serve the greater Lafayette community in this way.

DID YOU KNOW?...

...We hosted two mobile food trucks in 2017. The trucks were sponsored by Duke Energy and Cargill. Combined, the mobile food pantries distributed over 17,000 pounds of food to approximately 275 families (an estimated 1375 meals).
